**183rd MEETING OF THE COST
COMMITTEE OF SENIOR OFFICIALS^{1 2}
Brussels, 30 November - 1 December 2011**

The 183rd meeting of the COST Committee of Senior Officials (CSO) was held in Brussels on 30 November and 1 December 2011.

The meeting was chaired by **Dr Angeles Rodrigues Peña (ES)**, the President of the CSO. Part of the meeting was dedicated to a joint session with the 9 Chairs of the COST Domain Committees to discuss strategic initiatives in different domains, in line with the recently adopted COST strategy ([COST 4157/11](#)).

COST in Horizon 2020

The Committee discussed the role COST could play in the next Framework Programme for Research and Innovation “Horizon 2020”, building on its experience in running a well-functioning open networking scheme in S&T. The Committee intends to present a position paper in this respect with a view to the forthcoming discussions regarding Horizon 2020.
