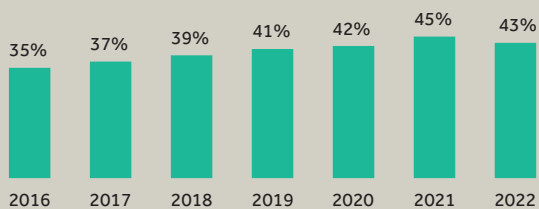

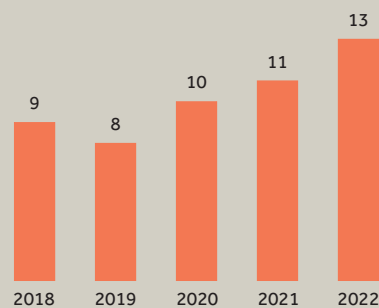

## COUNTRY REPRESENTATION IN COST ACTIONS



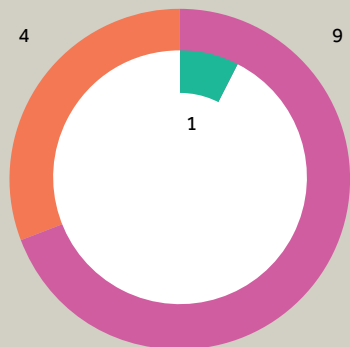

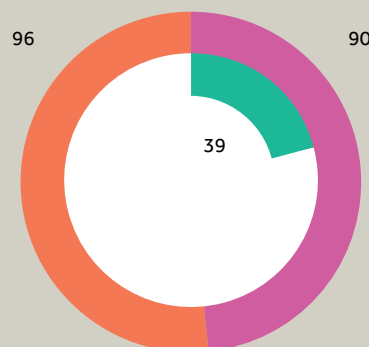

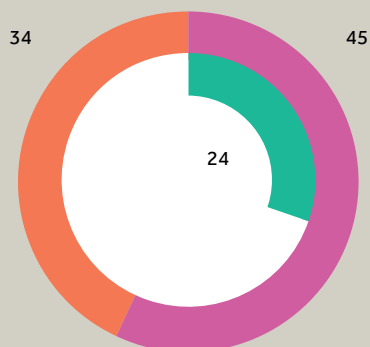
