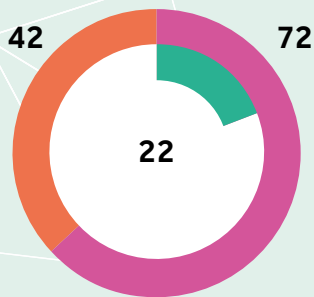

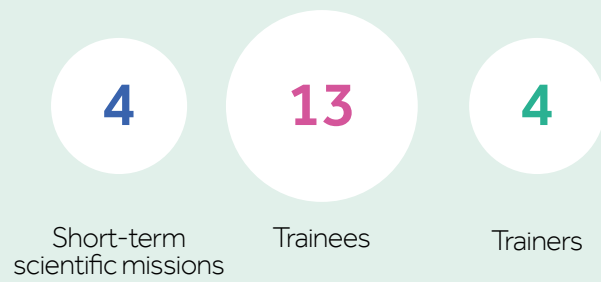

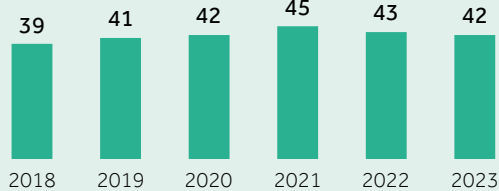
PARTICIPATION IN NETWORKING ACTIVITIES



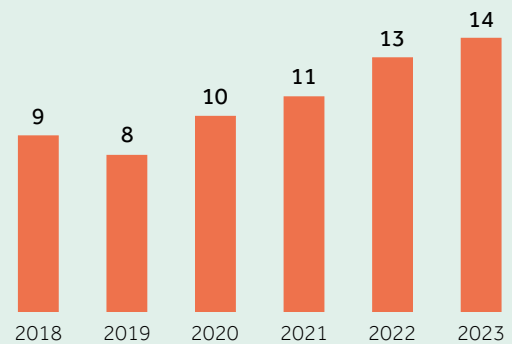
NETWORKING ACTIVITIES IN ICELAND



COUNTRY REPRESENTATION IN COST ACTIONS (%)

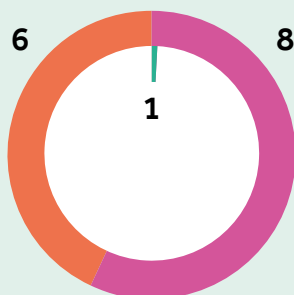


LEADERSHIP POSITIONS IN COST ACTIONS



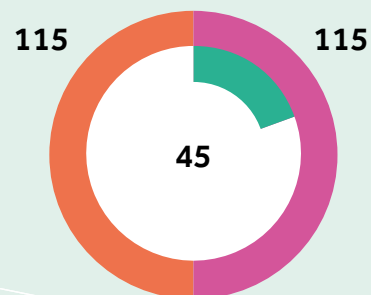
