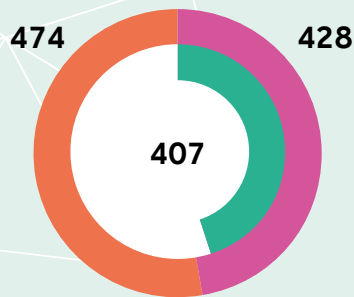

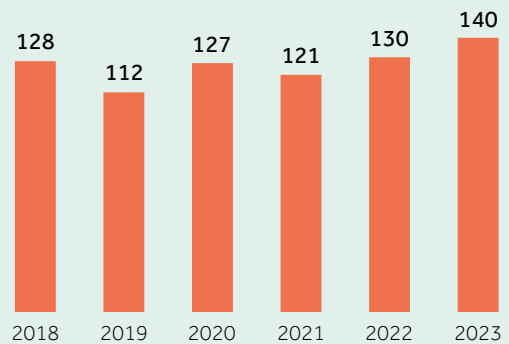
NETWORKING ACTIVITIES IN NETHERLANDS



COUNTRY REPRESENTATION IN COST ACTIONS (%)

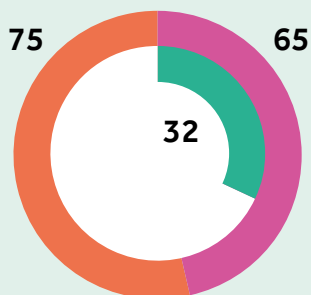


LEADERSHIP POSITIONS IN COST ACTIONS
