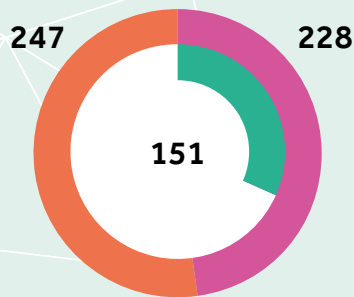

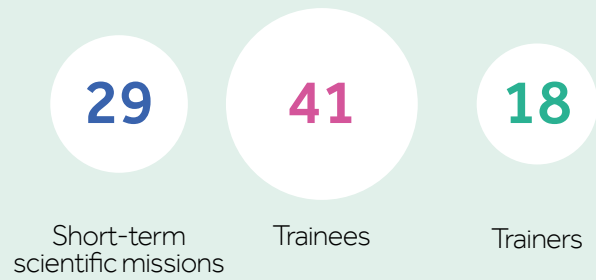

PARTICIPATION IN NETWORKING ACTIVITIES



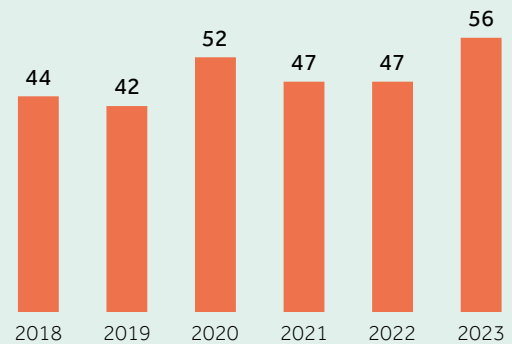
NETWORKING ACTIVITIES IN NORWAY



COUNTRY REPRESENTATION IN COST ACTIONS (%)

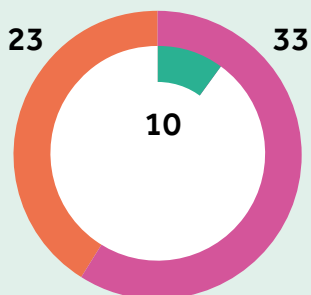


LEADERSHIP POSITIONS IN COST ACTIONS



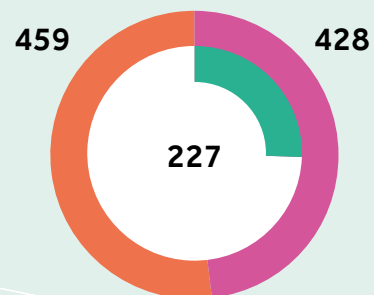
