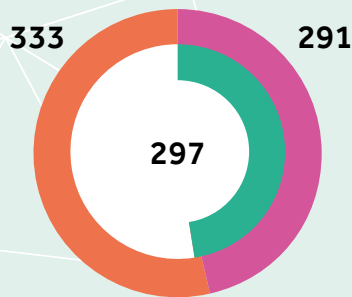

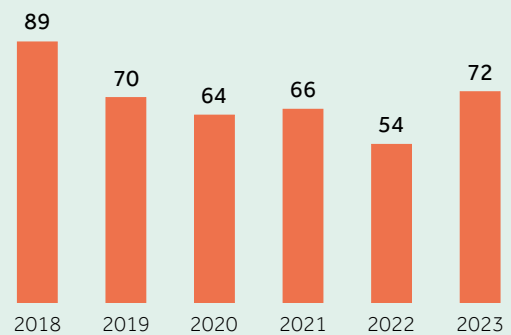
NETWORKING ACTIVITIES IN SWITZERLAND



COUNTRY REPRESENTATION IN COST ACTIONS (%)

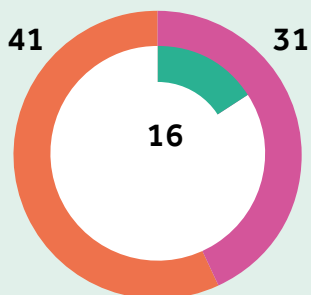


LEADERSHIP POSITIONS IN COST ACTIONS
