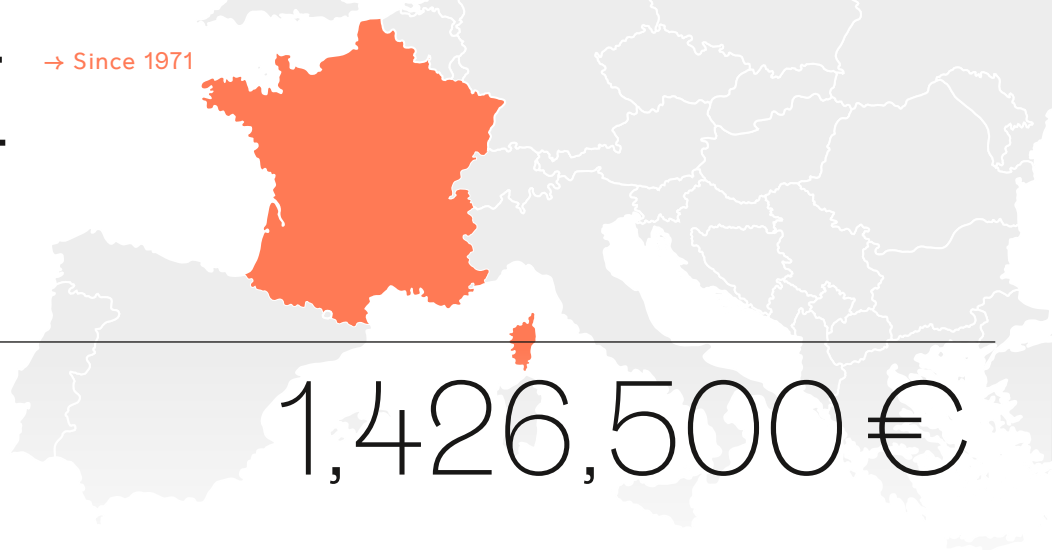

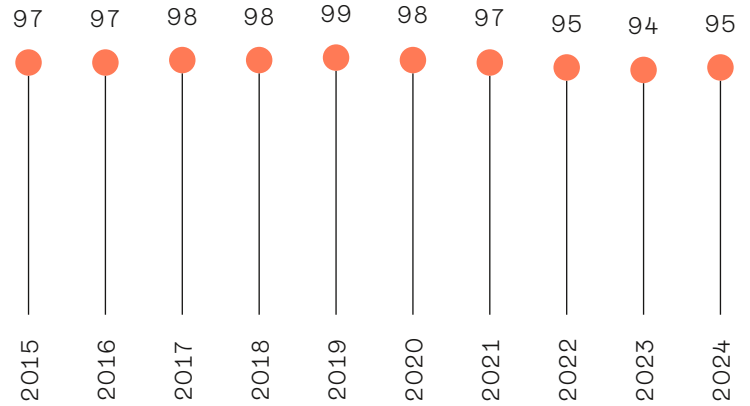

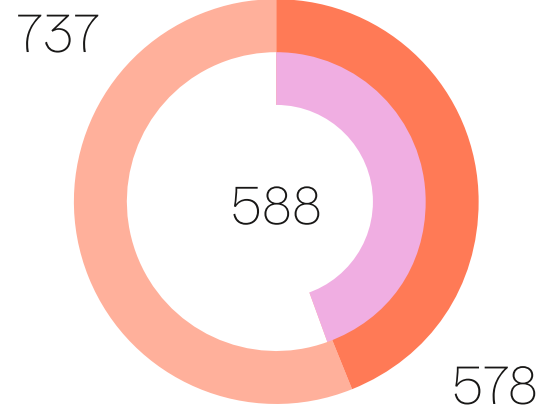
COUNTRY REPRESENTATION

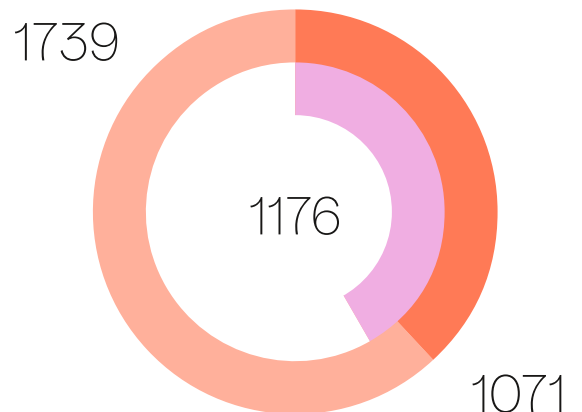

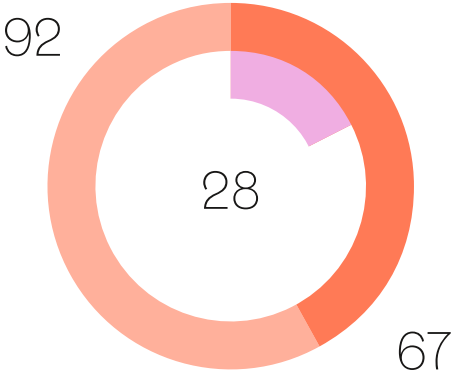

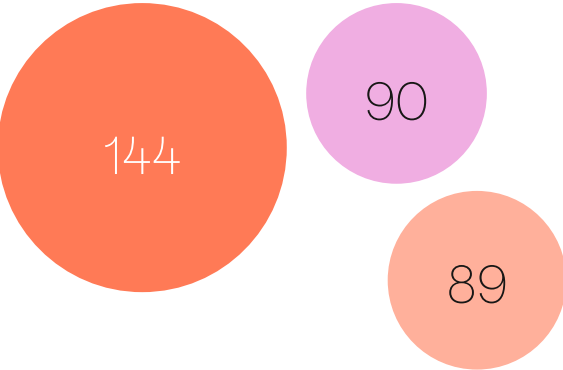
## LEADERSHIP POSITIONS IN COST ACTIONS

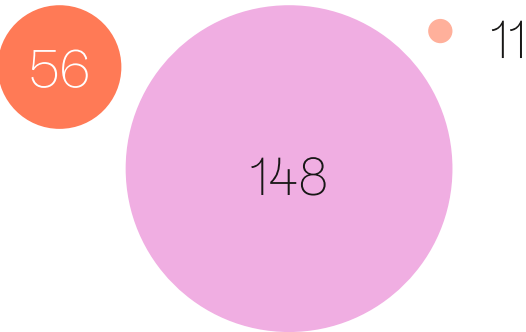
