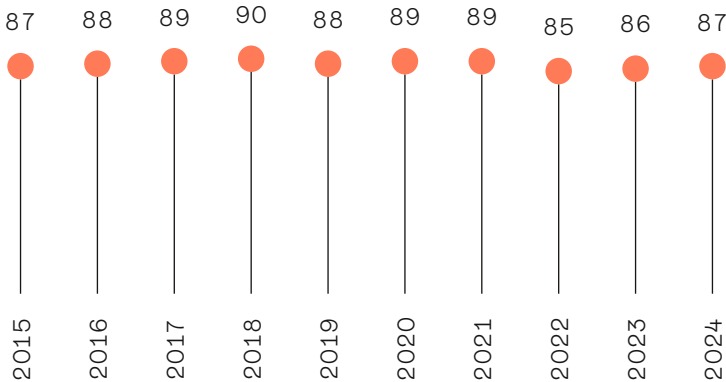

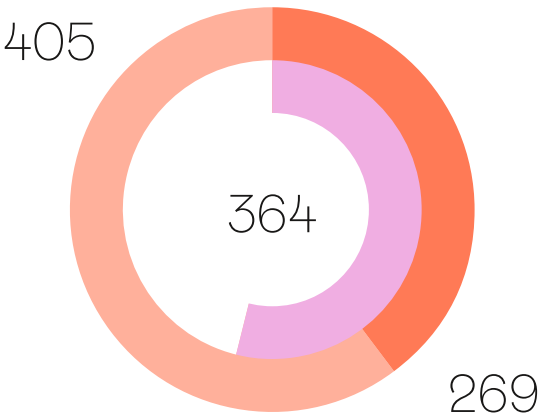
COUNTRY REPRESENTATION

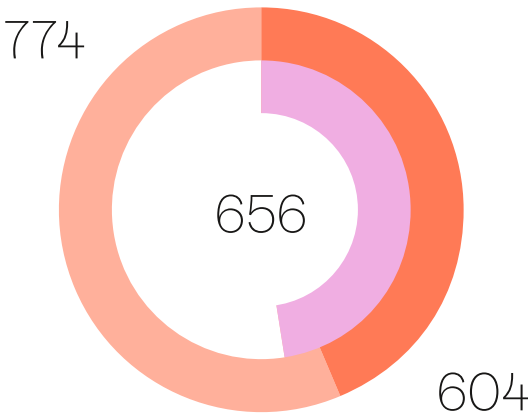

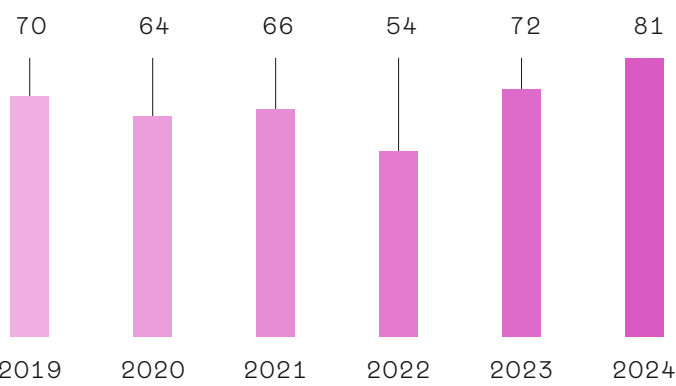

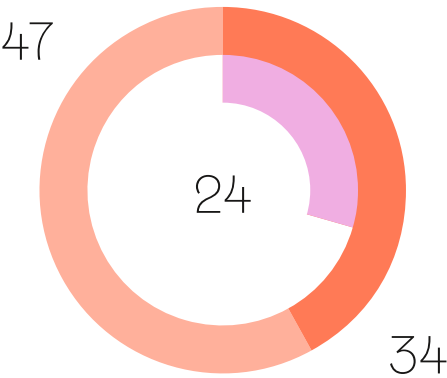

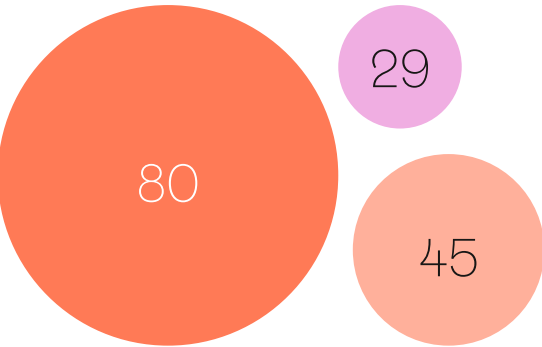
LEADERSHIP POSITIONS

LEADERSHIP IN DETAIL

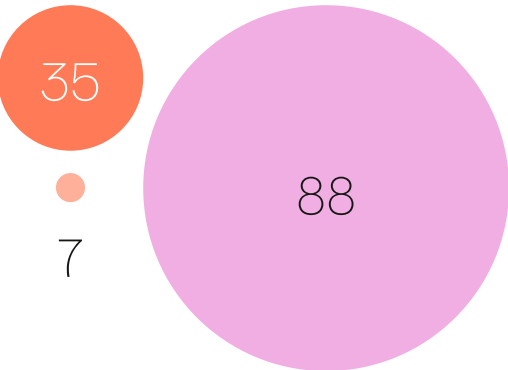
