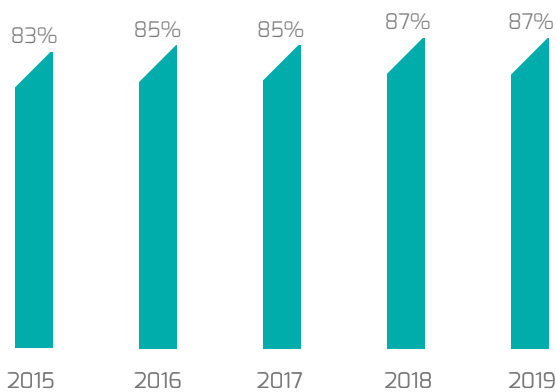

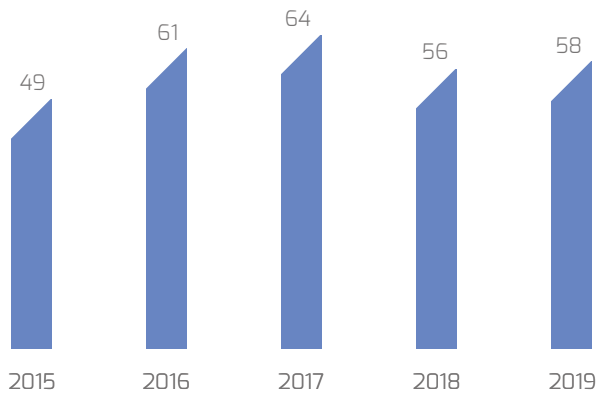

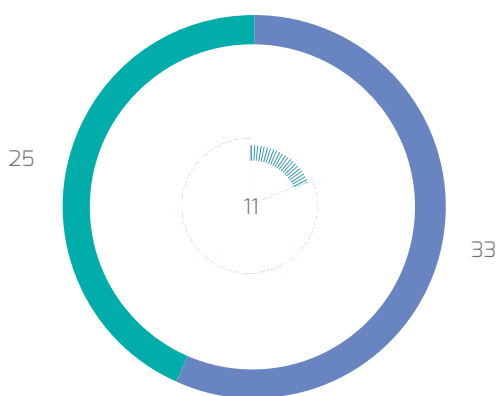


LEADERSHIP POSITIONS IN COST ACTIONS

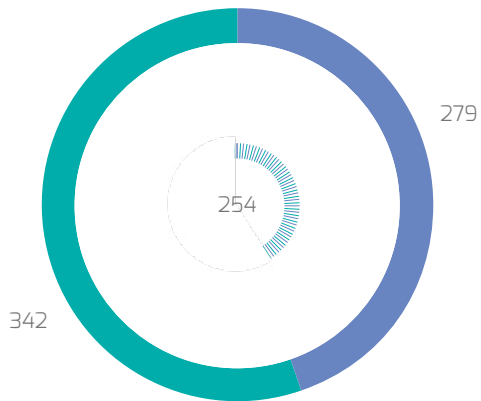

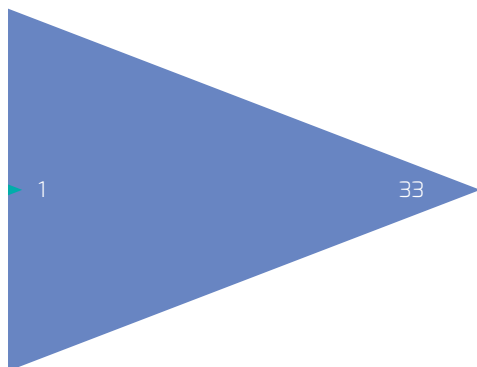
