Background for SACURIMA COST Action



- High risk of occupational fatalities, injuries and ill-health in agriculture
- Great variability in Eurostat accident statistics
- Great variations in organizations and programs that deal with the OSH for farmers in Europe
- Limited policy, implementation and funding for farm OSH at EU level.
- Target Audiences: Policy makers, OSH Experts; Farmers.



CAP – The Nine Objectives



EU OSH Directives are not applicable to self-employed, family workers

- 91% of farm work-force.
